Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Ballard Water Improvement District (BWID) culinary water system on 3500 East and 3000 North were financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The Drinking Water SRF program is administered by the Utah Division of Drinking Water (DDW) with joint funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Utah. This project will replace the aged and undersized culinary water pipelines on 3000 North from 3500 East to 2800 East and on 3500 East from 3000 North to 2300 North. Along with replacing the main lines, each existing service will be replaced to the customer side of the setter. Additionally, fire hydrants and appropriate valving for the system will be installed. These upgrades and improvements will increase the ability for BWID to serve existing customers in the upper zone, replace pipe nearing its expected lifespan, and decrease pressure loss during high flows necessary to fill the tank. This pipeline serves a large portion of the BWID system. The total project cost is \$2,215,000. DWSRF programs operate around the country to provide states and communities with the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources nationwide.
